Junior Branch (JB) Report

We started with the energizers "Gasolina" and "Pony." The activity revolved around the topic of media and news stories. JBers found 12 news stories (which had been secretly sorted into two groups: "well known" and "lesser known") and were tasked with creating a news segment about what they thought were the 5 most important stories. This activity encouraged participants to think about the importance of exploring the news for stories that might not be being covered. The debrief was full of lots of interesting insights about how to discover stories and share them with others.
