- Ask your kid's principal if they'd be willing to share information about BV with their school community. (If you aren't sure how to approach the principal, reach out to the BV recruitment committee for ideas.)
- If you're connected to any social, religious, or community groups that might be interested in learning about BV, let us know! (We have lots of flyers and other materials to share, as well as a ready-to-go PowerPoint presentation that gives a great overview of CISV.)

Junior Branch (JB) Report

We did "Get Loose" and "'60s Party" for energizers. For the activity, the JB played four different card games, and the board members periodically switched them between groups in the middle of the games. The first group of kids had the card game explained to them, then were instructed to be silent during the rest of the activity while other kids were switched to a different game.





The point of the activity was to illustrate the experience of a refugee entering a new country. As part of the debrief we watched a video from UNICEF about a young boy who was displaced from his home and moved to a refugee camp. The JB then did a self reflection where they thought of things that remind them of home. Then the group came together and discussed the issues facing refugees and how we can help them. We saw some great discussion revolving around empathy and kindness.
